- On Friday March 16, 2007, Rocky Hill Police Chief Michael D. Custer graduated from the two hundred and twenty eighth session of the FBI National Academy, located at Quantico, Virginia. The class was comprised of two hundred and sixty three law enforcement professionals from forty eight states, the District of Columbia, twenty three international countries, four military organizations, and five civilian organizations.
- The FBI National Academy is internationally known for its academic excellence. The program provides participants with ten weeks of advanced investigative, management and fitness training to selected officers with a proven record of professionalism within their agencies.
